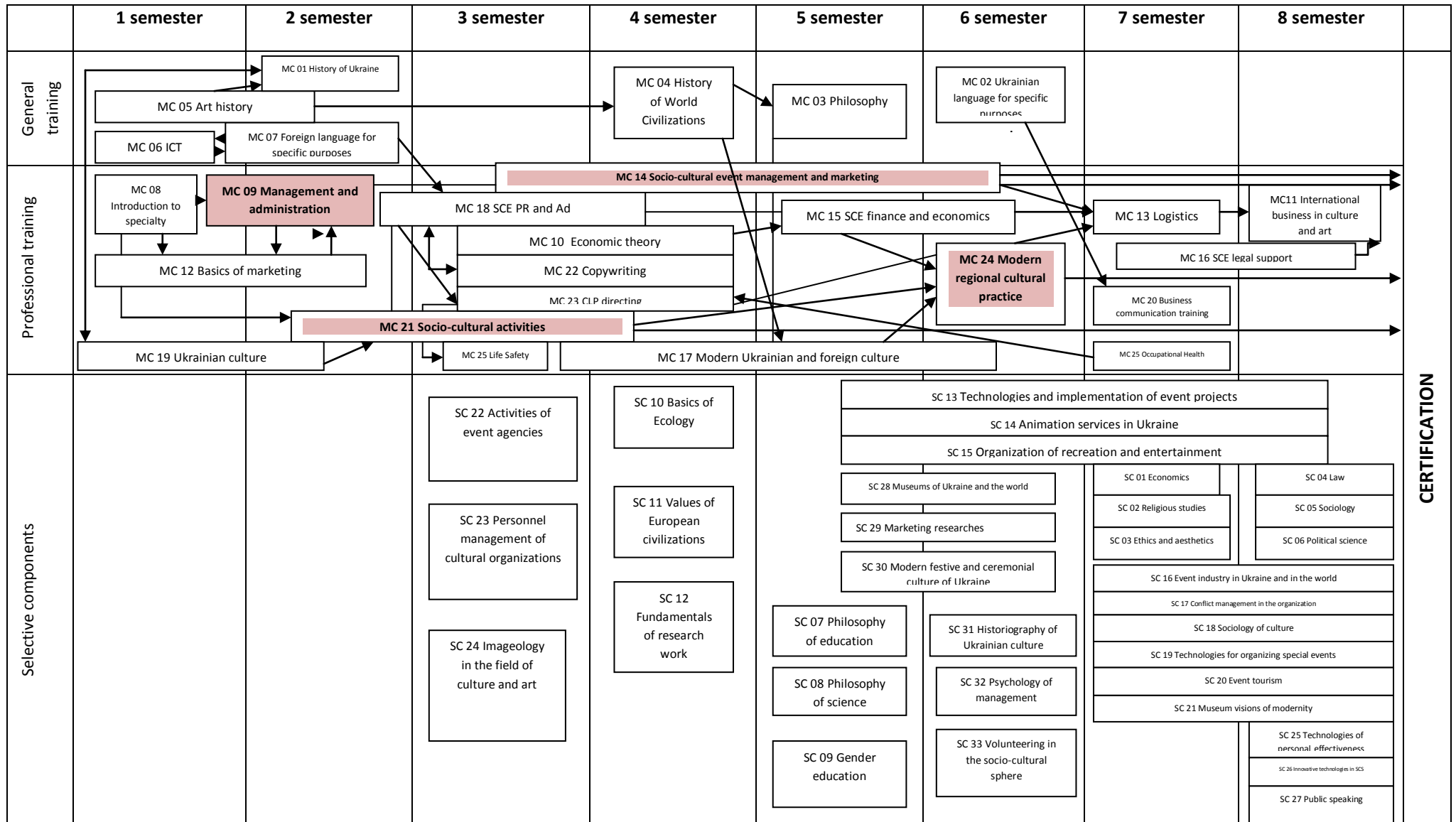

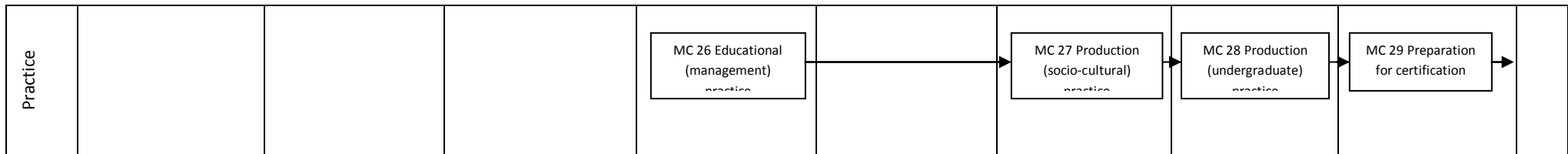
2.2. Structural and logic scheme of EPP

3. Form of certification of higher education applicants

Certification of graduates of the educational professional program in specialty 028 “Socio-Cultural Event Management” is conducted in the form of certification exam in the specialty or public defense of the qualification (bachelor's) thesis and ends with the issuance of the standardized certificate of awarding a bachelor degree with the qualification: Bachelor of Socio-Cultural Event Management.

The certification should be open and public.

The following disciplines are taken for the certification exam in the specialty: “Management and Administration,” “Socio-cultural event management and marketing,” “Socio-Cultural Activities,” “Modern Regional Cultural Practice.”

The certification exam in the specialty involves the performance of a set of qualification tasks: theoretical questions, practical situational and complex tasks.

The forms of the certification exam in the specialty can be: written and oral.

Qualification (bachelor's) thesis involves the analysis and theoretical development (modeling and research of processes and objects) of current issues, problems in the relevant field of knowledge. The list of themes of qualification (bachelor's) thesis in specialty is determined by the graduating department at the beginning of the academic year. The subject matter of the qualification (bachelor's) thesis should be directly related to the general object of the relevant educational level of specialist's activity. The list of themes of qualification (bachelor's) thesis is approved by the order of the rector before the beginning of production (undergraduate) practice. Students have the right to propose for consideration their own theme of qualification (bachelor's) thesis.

Qualification (bachelor's) thesis assignments should reflect all production functions and typical tasks of the specialist's activity and must be brought to the student in a timely manner (before the beginning of production (undergraduate) practice).

The heads of qualification (bachelor's) thesis can be professors, associate professors, senior lecturers of the graduating department, as well as leading experts in the field of education.

The certification of bachelor's degree applicants is carried out by the Examination Commission, which may include representatives of employers and their associations in accordance with the provisions of the Examination Commission approved by the Academic Council of Rivne State University of Humanities.


6. System of internal assurance of higher education quality

Rivne State University of Humanities operates a system of assurance of educational activity and higher education quality (system of internal quality assurance), which provides the implementation of the following procedures and measures:

- 5) providing the availability of the necessary resources for organizing the educational process, including the independent work of higher education applicants on each educational program;
- 6) ensuring the availability of information systems for effective management of the educational process;
- 7) ensuring publicity of information on educational programs, degrees of higher education and qualification;
- 8) ensuring an effective system of preventing and detecting academic plagiarism in the scientific works of higher education institutions employees and applicants;
- 9) other procedures and measures.
