Each author (co-author) will be issued a personalized certificate of participation (equivalent to 0.2 ECTS credits – 6 hours), which will be sent along with the electronic conference proceedings to the email address provided in the application form.

To participate in the conference please submit the following materials to the Hosting Committee (e-mail: olg2686@gmail.com) by **May 10, 2026**:

- 1) an application for participation in the conference (*Appendix 1*) – must be completed separately for each co-author;
- 2) abstracts of the report, formatted in the accordance with the requirements (*Appendix 2*);
- 3) a copy of the registration fee payment receipt.

File names must include the surname and initials of the conference participant (for example, Kovalenko_application, Kovalenko_abstracts, Kovalenko_receipt). Students may submit abstracts co-authored with their research supervisor.

After submitting the materials to the specified address, the author will receive confirmation from the organizing committee within three days. If no confirmation is received, please contact the organizing committee by phone or resubmit the materials.

REGISTRATION FEE

To participate in the scientific conference and have your materials included in the electronic proceedings, a registration fee of 150 UAH is required. (The fee covers website hosting, layout of the collection, and an electronic certificate).

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PRESENTATION OF ABSTRACTS IN THE CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS

The volume of the electronic version of the abstract text is 4-6 full pages of A4 format, typed in Microsoft Word as a computer file with the extension *.doc, *.docx.

Margins: all page margins – 2.0 cm; alignment – width. **Text font** – Times New Roman, **size** – 14, **paragraph indentation** – 1 cm, **line spacing** – 1,5. Pages are not numbered. No hyphenations are allowed.

Abstracts are not reviewed. Authors bear full responsibility for maintaining academic integrity, the content of their materials, and the accuracy of facts, citations, proper names, and other information.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject materials that do not meet the requirements and issues of the conference or were received after May 10, 2026.

The sequence of placing materials in the abstracts of the report:

The first line should contain the name of the thematic section (Italicized, left-aligned).

The second line should include the author's (or co-authors') first and last names (Bold Italic, right aligned).

The third line should include the academic degree and title (if applicable) (Italicized, right aligned).

The fourth line should state the position and name of the institution representing the participant (Italicized, right aligned).

The fifth line should be the title of the research paper (ALL CAPS, Bold, centered).

Following this, an abstract (2-3 sentences) and keywords (5-7 items) must be provided in italics, in the same language as the research materials.

In-text citations are enclosed in square brackets according to the following format: [4, p. 45], where the first number indicates the source sequence in the reference list, and the second refers to the page number.

The list of references and literature should be arranged in alphabetical order and formatted according to the standards for bibliographic description (DSTU 8302:2015, Information and documentation. Bibliographic references. General principles and rules for composition.)
