

Requirements for qualification (bachelor's) thesis	Qualification (bachelor's) thesis should contain a solution of a complex specialized task or practical problem in the socio-cultural sphere, in the field of education and science, creative economy and cultural practices, which involves the use of theories and methods of cultural management and is characterized by complexity and uncertainty of conditions. There should not be academic plagiarism, falsification or fabrication in the qualification (bachelor's) thesis. Qualification work must be published for defense on the official website of the higher education institution or its subdivision, or in the depository of the higher education institution.
Requirements for certification exam.	The certification examination should provide verification of learning outcomes achievements, integral, general and professional competencies defined by the standard and the educational program.
